On behalf of the Nuffield International Farming Scholarship program, I am pleased to advise that you have been approved as a 2025 Nuffield International Farming Scholar. I want to congratulate you on this prestigious achievement and welcome you to the Nuffield family!

A Nuffield International Farming Scholarship is the opportunity of a lifetime. It opens doors to agriculture around the world and admits you to a select network of its leading operators and businesspeople. For most, it is the beginning of a lifetime of learning and social opportunities. The opportunity and privilege you have won is the cumulative result of the efforts of scholars and investors over the last 75 years.

Nuffield International is deeply committed to your participation in a quality program. The active period of your scholarship period is 15 weeks, and the travel program will include the Contemporary Scholars Conference (CSC) in New Zealand as well as a Global Focus Program (GFP) plus your individual study. More details will be provided to you in due course.

Your scholarship entitles you to a bursary of US\$25,000 to be used for participation in the CSC, GFP, your individual study travels, as well as a final written report and presentation at the completion of your studies. Please note that we will withhold the funds required to cover the CSC and GFP from your bursary, so you do not need to take action to pay for these events.

Any expenditure in excess of your bursary will be paid by you personally. This may include, participating in post-CSC tours, travel at the end of your GFP or in order to complete your scholarship contract of a total of 15 weeks travel. This is detailed in the Scholar Agreement.

Program Details

All selected Nuffield Scholars in the year 2025 from around the world will gather for the week-long Contemporary Scholars Conference (CSC) in Auckland, New Zealand from 8 to 16 March 2025. This event provides you with a global platform of knowledge and contacts that will serve you for the rest of your life. More details will be provided to you very soon.

The five-week Global Focus Program (GFP) is compulsory for Nuffield International Scholars and is organized by Nuffield Australia. Your individual study travels should ideally commence after your GFP. You will self-organize your individual study travels portion of your scholarship, which should take the remaining eight weeks of your contracted required travel. Whether you choose to return home during

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this period is up to you, however time and travel must be managed within the remainder of your bursary budget, or at your own expense. More details on the bursary can be found in the Scholar Agreement.

You are expected to complete your study and final written report within ten months of your GFP departure date. If, as that time approaches, you have not completed your studies you are able to request an extension to your submission date. You will make your verbal presentations at the end of your travel period at an event(s) to be identified in your home country.

Your obligations as a Nuffield Scholar are to:

1. Comply with the Nuffield International Scholar Agreement and Code of Conduct (attached for your review and signature). We strongly advise you check with your legal advisor to ensure you fully understand your obligations. Signed copies of the contract will be exchanged ASAP.
2. Attend the CSC in New Zealand in March 2025, details to be advised.
3. Participate in a GFP, spanning up to 35 days of consecutive group travel.
4. Conduct your own research into your chosen topic area, using the Nuffield network for support.
5. Prepare a formal report of 7,000-10,000 words (in your native language, with an Executive Summary in English) within ten months of participating in your GFP.
6. Present to Nuffield International, our corporate supporters and the media at appropriate functions; and
7. Proactively seek opportunities to promote and extend the reach of your report and travels, working with Nuffield International and investors to share your findings with the wider agricultural community.

Embrace this opportunity with all your energy. Remember that as you travel you build on the legacy of those who have gone before you and you play an important part as ambassadors for the Nuffield program and for global agriculture. We trust that you will embrace the spirit of this great organization, help carry forward our traditions, present yourself well, and be mindful of those who offer assistance and hospitality during this journey.
